

Indoor Worship Plan

General Guidelines

- **DO NOT attend indoor worship if you are feeling sick or have any symptoms of Covid-19 such as fever, dry cough, or shortness of breath.**
- We know you will come in love; meaning for the good of others. Thanks for being willing to bend to the needs of your brothers, sisters, moms and dads in Christ who are at-risk or vulnerable.
- We now want to show our love by refraining from hugs, handshakes, and other physical contact.
- You will need to stay on the main floor of the church building. Please do not go downstairs and refrain from non-worship church activities on Sunday morning.
- Families will worship together in the worship center. There will be no separate children or youth activities and the nursery will be closed.
- Masks are required for all indoor worship attenders for the entirety of the time you are in the building.

Before Arrival

- You must register for indoor worship in order to attend.
- You may register by signing up on the church website or calling the church office. Registration for Sunday will open the Tuesday before.
- You must register everybody in your family who will be attending.
- **DO NOT attend indoor worship if you are feeling sick or have any symptoms of Covid-19 such as fever, dry cough, or shortness of breath.**

Entrance and Greeting

- Please arrive no earlier than 15 minutes before the beginning of worship.
- A greeter will ask your name in order to keep track of our registrations.
- Please move directly towards the worship center in order to be seated.

Seating

- Upon entering the worship center you will be invited to pick up a bulletin.
- An usher will direct you to a seat. We will start seating farthest away from the entrance to the worship center and move back towards the doors.
- All rows of chairs will be set up six feet apart.
- Each row will have two six foot foam noodles. This shows you the distance you should sit from others (roughly four chairs). Please use those to space yourself from others.
- Once you are seated you are asked to remain in your chair. Do not get up to greet others.

Service Details

- You will be given a bulletin but we will not be passing out hymnals.
- We will not be passing offering plates. You are welcome to drop your offering in plates while entering or exiting the worship center.

Exiting

- Please move towards the doors to exit at the end of the service.
- You are welcome to exit through the atrium. You are also welcome to exit through the north doors of the Worship Center if you would like to avoid contact with those attending the next service.
- When we begin multiple indoor services, if you are attending the **8:15 or 9:25** service we ask that you make an extra effort of hospitality to leave quickly so that we have the opportunity to clean and prepare for the arrival of those attending later services.

For Pastors, Staff, and Other Volunteers

- Those participating in the service (ushers, musicians, sound techs) will not be required to register online.
- Pastors, staff, and those participating in the service will wear masks when not leading the service and will work to maintain social distance during the worship service.
